

## Directions to UConn – Bishop Center

### FROM THE NORTH (I-91):

Take I-91 South towards Hartford. Take exit 35A towards Manchester on I-291 East and go about 6 miles. Take the I-84 East exit towards Boston for about 12.5 miles to exit 68 (Route 195). Take RTE 195 South approximately 7 miles to campus (crossing over routes 32 and 44).

Starting from the “University of Connecticut” sign on your right, follow straight through four sets of lights. At the 5<sup>th</sup> light, take a left (there is a blue sign on the left for Bishop Center). The Bishop Center is the second building on the left. There is parking available behind the building (see map below). Registration will be on the ground floor.

### FROM INTERSTATE 84:

Take I-84 East/West to Exit 68. Take RTE 195 South approx 7 miles to campus (crossing over routes 32 and 44).

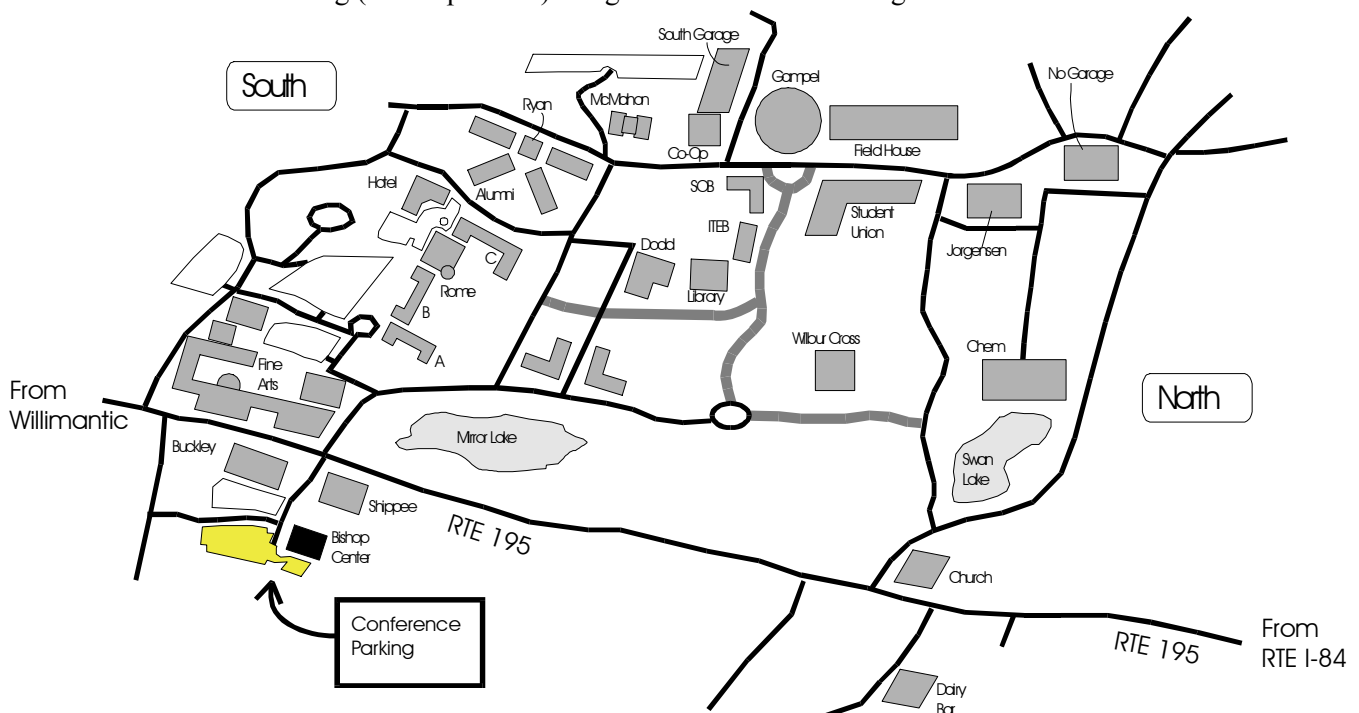
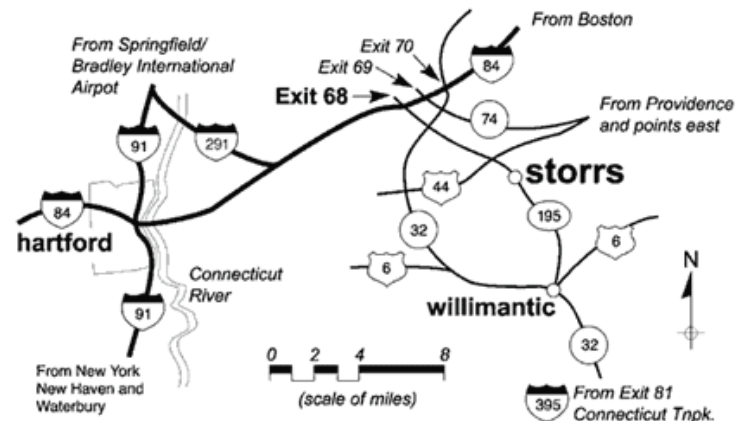
Starting from the “University of Connecticut” sign on your right, follow straight through four sets of lights. At the 5<sup>th</sup> light, take a left (there is a blue sign on the left for Bishop Center). The Bishop Center is the second building on the left. There is parking available behind the building (see map below). Registration will be on the ground floor.

### FROM SOUTHEASTERN CONNECTICUT:

Take RTE 32 and continue North to Willimantic. At Willimantic, follow the signs for RTE 195 for approx 8 miles to the campus.

Starting at the “University of Connecticut” sign on your right (at the junction of RTE 195 and RTE 275) continue straight through three sets of lights (passing three shopping plazas on the right). At the 4<sup>th</sup> light turn left (there is a blue sign on the left for Bishop Center). The Bishop Center is the second building on the left. There is parking available behind the building (see map below). Registration will be on the ground floor.
